



HERDSA-TERNZ Medal 2018 Nomination Form

The HERDSA-TERNZ medal is presented annually (usually during the TERNZ conference in November) for work that has contributed outstandingly to tertiary education research in New Zealand. As the medal is prestigious, HERDSA New Zealand reserves the right not to award the medal in a year lacking nominees judged to be sufficiently meritorious.

Criteria:

The medal is awarded to a team or individual who has contributed outstandingly to tertiary education research in New Zealand. This includes tertiary education research itself and/or service to tertiary education research.

Nominators:

Eligible nominators are HERDSA members, academic developers, and active researchers in the field of tertiary education research.

Nomination process:

You may nominate another person or team, or self-nominate. Please address the following sections in the nomination.

1. Up to 500 words explaining the significance of the individual's or team's contribution(s) with reference to the criteria (above), written in plain language and understandable by judges with a general tertiary education background.
2. References to relevant publications, if applicable.
3. A brief curriculum vitae of the nominee, if possible.
4. Contact details for nominee(s) and nominator: Name (with title), postal address, email address, and phone number.

Additional statements (up to one page) with more detailed support for the nomination by the nominator (and by other supporters) may be included with the nomination papers.
